

Hello, my name is firefighter Matt Davis and I am writing to you today on behalf of the North Andover Fire Department. We are here tonight asking for a donation in the amount of \$540.00 to cover the cost of this years fire prevention and education supplies. The money donated will pay for plastic fire helmets, children's NAFD mood bracelets, as well as the coloring books that are given out in grades K- 2 each year.

We use the coloring books as a teaching tool when we teach grades K - 2 in all public and private schools in North Andover. These books teach kids the basic fire safety skills including: 911, get out and stay out, stop - drop - and roll, and how to evacuate safely. We use the NAFD mood bracelets and plastic fire helmets as giveaways, to build a positive relationship with children and their families.

I like to consider these supplies a year round teaching tool. We start off with the classroom and fire safety house presentations in the months of April, May, and June. We again give them out at the North Andover National Night Out in August. We took part in this years North Andover Fall Festival, where we gave out over 150 bracelets and 150 helmets in a matter of two hours. Lastly, we give out the remainder of the years supplies at our NAFD open house which is scheduled for Saturday, October 8th.

These supplies are a vital part of our education methods and we hope you consider donating once again. We take pride in educating our youth, and all town residents. I thank you on behalf of the North Andover Fire Department.
